If you run a dog in Open then you cannot run a dog in Novice. Cross entering between classes will be allowed except not Novice to Open. Novice course will allow handlers to walk the course to help their dog. Pro Novice will have a short drive. Open will have a drive and possibly a shed. Pre-competition is for open handlers who want to run a young dog to give it experience in arenas and in competition but want to be able to leave the post and go out and help their young dog. Pre-competition will be judged but it is not a sanctioned class. Open and Pro Novice will be in the field – small field trial format. Novice and Pre-competition will be held in a small arena area.
